BP is the operator of the second largest crude pipeline in the world: the Baku-Tbilisi-Ceyhan (BTC) pipeline. It exports crude oil from the Caspian to world markets. The 1,768 km route runs from the onshore terminal at Sangachal, near Baku, through Georgia to a new marine export terminal at Ceyhan, on the Turkish Mediterranean coast, thus avoiding the Turkish Straits.
